- Communicate with sound designers, Production Manager, rental houses, and other suppliers to achieve the desired sound design within the given budget
- Coordinate all rentals and purchases needed for each design
- Hire and manage over hire sound technicians as needed for install/strike of per show systems
- Organize and run per show sound tuning session
- Cleaning, repairing and maintaining sound inventory
- Creating and maintaining appropriate per show paperwork
- Install and set up of speakers and wireless mics as designed per show
- Install and set up audio and video monitors as needed per show
- Set up and maintain wired and wireless clear com system
- Run notes calls, program sound board, and attend production meetings during tech and previews.
- Coordinate with the Curiosity department to arrange for the design and execution of all related performances including Young Ensemble, and Summer Camps
- Maintain Assisted Listening Devices
- Run all previews and performances
